We Grow Better Together!

Growing up in the country offered many first-hand experiences city-life could have never provided. Walt was a friend in high school who had responsibilities for managing the family hatchery. On occasion, I would help him tend to his chores after school so that we could move on to higher priorities of boys our age. I quickly learned that the environment of an egg had to be carefully maintained to produce a baby chick. Temperature, humidity, and ventilation were critical to success.

In a similar fashion, Village Bible Church (VBC) is in the business of producing "...disciples who become growing and serving followers of Jesus Christ." I have discovered there is also a favorable environment toward the production of healthy disciples. God never intended for any of us to live the Christian life alone. Rather, the Apostle Paul informs us, "we are to grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ, from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love" (Eph. 4:15b-16). The body of Christ is better together living in harmony to foster personal growth and accomplish the greater work of His church.

In his recent book, *Escape Routes*, Pastor Johann Arnold declares, "Forget about the Information Age: we live in the age of Ioneliness. He argues, "... Ioneliness has never been as widespread as it is today. Let's face it, all of us will disappoint or be disappointed at some

juncture; we will hurt others and be hurt; we will be mistrusted, and we will mistrust. But to avoid such interaction in relationships will impede the maturity that must occur in lifelong discipleship. Russian author Dostoyevsky, half-jokingly said, "...though he loved humanity, he couldn't stand individuals." Oftentimes, our actions unwittingly mirror his view. As pastors, we are resolved to nurture R.E.A.L. community at VBC. It all begins with Relationships one with another – living life together. The good times, and the hard times. Times of victory, and times of defeat. Times of great hope, and other times of crippling discouragement.

The "incubator" for such fast-track development is a Small Group. Small Groups meet on a regular basis to fellowship, pray, and study God's Word together. Each week the pastors provide questions for discussion at Small Group meetings. The Small Group time provides a wonderful opportunity to apply the lessons learned in the sermon. Sermons share lots of great information, illustrations, and explanations of biblical texts. When a group connects with a weekly sermon, a natural outcome is to ask how the sermon applied directly to each life in the group. What a wonderful way to connect with others, and continue in your personal growth and development as a disciple.

Be sure to sign-up during the month of February during open-enrollment. Join a group, start a new group, or simply move to another group to meet new people.

VBC has devised a single sheet "Funeral or Memorial Service Preparation Guideline" to assist you in doing this. It will guide you with some simple questions to help you make a Christian statement of your faith after you are gone.

Simply stop by the Welcome Center or the church office during the week and request one. Fill it out, and return it to the church. We will photocopy it so that you may keep it with your personal papers, and we will retain a copy on file in the church office. Let this be one tool to help you exalt Jesus in life ... as well as in death.

This is an annual orientation, planning, and training meeting to better care for our VBC family.

The categories of service include: Hospital Visitation, GriefShare, Homebound Ministry, Inpatient and Outpatient prayer needs, Home Needs (minor and temporary); some aspects of the Deaconess Ministry which includes: Memorial Service Care, Food Preparation, Flowers and

Cards of Encouragement.

Also, the Deacon's Ministry intersects with the Care Team including: Transportation, Congregational Support (Minor Home Repair/Errands), and the Mercy Ministry (Food Boxes and Benevolence Needs).

We will review the role of the Care Ministry and our philosophy of attending to those needs as well as reviewing and making assignments in the respective areas and sharing any changes in protocol that have evolved in the last year.

What a wonderful year 2016 turned out to be! We are thrilled to fill you in on some of the highlights, and anxious to share some of the things that God has in store for 2017.



2016 hosted many blessings for Change Point and the families we served! Just this past year, God has used us to:

- Assist over 2,600 families in crisis, averaging 600 visits per month.
- Minister to 150-200 parents per month through our parenting classes.
- ◆ Share Jesus (and diapers!) through our "Earn While You Learn" diapers-for-Bible Study exchange program.
- Encourage 54 mothers to make the choice to give the gift of life to their unborn babies, which now puts our grand total over the 2,500 mark!

As great as 2016 was, we are even more excited about what's yet to come in 2017. God has been busy working to spread the mission of Change Point across the state of Arkansas through Judge H. H. Singleton. Judge Singleton has been so impressed with our program, he has begun the process of sending us to 7 counties in the state to train churches and volunteers to become branches of our ministry! We are currently in the process of training a group of volunteers in Sheridan to provide parenting classes for the Clark County area. Training dates for the remaining six counties are yet to be determined, but will be scheduled as soon as possible.

Please contact us to find out about our many volunteer opportunities! We have a need for volunteers in all of our departments and greatly appreciate the donation of your time and effort. We depend on our volunteers to help us spread the message of Jesus and touch families' lives every day, and we are currently experiencing a shortage. Any amount of time in any capacity would bless our ministry incredibly!

As always, we thank you for your continued support. Change Point wouldn't be able to operate at our capacity without your calling to give.


ELDER BOARD REPORT


