Note: Since the sermons are previously recorded, they will not be heard on the same Sunday as preached at VBC.






# ELDER BOARD REFLECTIONS by Bruce Davis

### GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT January - March, Fellowship Hall

Scripture reveals that the Holy Spirit was involved in Creation (Gen. 1) and will be involved in the Consummation of the heavens and the earth (Rev. 22). So, what is He doing between these Alpha and Omega events? What is the Spirit doing NOW?
