HOW MUCH DO YOU LOVE JESUS?

In His last will and testament (John 14), Jesus himself gives us His yard stick for measuring the love of His followers. "If you love me, keep my commandments." That's clear. Very straightforward. As a reminder, the Bible is a Book of Commands. Moses did not return from Mt. Sinai with the 10 Suggestions. God is quite specific what He expects of us. So how do YOU measure up to Jesus' standard? Three times in John 14 Jesus repeats this measurement for His followers. If you love me, you will keep my words/commandments. It should be obvious that we cannot obey what we don't know. The only way to know is obey a later command: If Timothy 2:15. STUDY God's Word!



In Bible study, Christians have a tutor: the Holy Spirit. He is the author of THE BOOK. And part of His job is to "call to remembrance" Jesus' words as we grow toward Christ-likeness. But the Spirit cannot call to your remembrance what you haven't studied. Of course we all need to be more familiar with God's Word in order to express our love for Jesus through obedience.

Every Sunday morning after the service, God Himself invites you to have a spiritual dessert in one of several Spirit inspired Bible studies. And the Spirit is a master chef.

Therefore, fellow traveler toward heaven, the question re-appears. HOW MUCH DO YOU LOVE JESUS? He says that obedience is His standard for us. One way to obey the command to STUDY is to come invest 55 minutes of your life in obedience, and study God's Word in one of our excellent growth experiences: a Bible study from 10:50 - 11:45. Then just watch your love for the Savior grow!
