

There will be a baptismal service at Lake Balboa on Sunday, May 26th in conjunction with the church picnic at Balboa Pavilion. If you have not been baptized, you may wonder why it's important.

Baptism was commanded by Jesus: The great Commission is given in Matthew 28:19 "*Go therefore and make disciples of all nations,* <u>baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy</u> <u>Spirit.</u> 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you…" This commission gives us Jesus' last instructions before ascending to the Father and carries great weight as to what is a priority.

Baptism follows believing: Baptism is the first act of obedience after believing. Phillip shared the Gospel with the Ethiopian Eunuch in Acts chapter 8. He then asked the question, "what hinders me from being baptized?" Phillip answered, "You can if you believe with all of your heart." The Eunuch professed his belief and they both went down into the water and he was baptized.

Baptism identifies us with Jesus' death, burial and resurrection: Romans 6:3 "Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death? 4 <u>Therefore we</u> have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life."

Baptism is an opportunity to profess your faith publicly: Romans 10:9,10 gives instruction to believe in our hearts and to profess with our mouth the Lord Jesus. Making your profession public gives confidence in your believing.

To all my Church Family: Most would know that I spent the month of March in Australia assisting my daughter Tracie after her surgery. She has been the beneficiary of a huge prayer chain – from all of you here at VBC as well as other churches in the Village and churches in other states, and she felt its power! Tracie asked me to pass on to each of you who prayed for her,

her gratitude for taking the time and making the effort to ask our Lord to guide the surgeon's hands and to put her on the road to recovery. The surgeon's hands were, in fact, both required to be inside her chest cavity, literally scraping the solidified silicon from her chest wall. There is no guarantee that tiny flakes or specks of the stuff did not escape into her system. Time will tell. As we were leaving Brisbane on April 4, she was readmitted to hospital for two nights to have an IV of powerful antibiotics administered to ward off yet another infection that had begun. She has since sent me a message to say she is home, being monitored and "all is well". There is no doubt that the Lord put this particular surgeon in her path as over the last three years of various manifestations of illnesses to one degree or another, the medical profession had no idea what was the cause and continued to send her from one specialist to another to yet another, trying to come up with the proper diagnosis. When this particular surgeon was made aware of her plight, seemingly by chance, he knew immediately that the cause was a long-ruptured breast implant and only immediate surgery to remove all signs of it would save her life. Another year of their "medical practice" and she would have died. So, to God be the Glory and my thanks to you wonderful people of VBC. You are indeed my church family and have been since that wonderful day in 2012 when I first set foot in our church. The fact that God used the wiles of a woman to get me here is a whole other story! 




