#### **Rest in God's Sovereign Control**

I'm grateful to finally be here with you after these last several months of transition. I praise God for His faithfulness and I thank you for your diligent prayers and abundant support. Perhaps you can relate to all these transitions my family has been undergoing, especially as you reflect on your transition to the Village. Maybe you were excited or maybe you were apprehensive of the unknown, but you made the transition.

There are variety of big life transitions that we all experience, some are hard, and some are easy. I've been encouraged by the Word of God through a variety of transitions, especially in relation to His Sovereignty. Proverbs 16:1, "The plans of the heart belong to man, But the answer of the tongue is from the Lord." The idea is that a person makes plans, but the ultimate result is from the Lord. What will the future hold for you as an individual or for us a church? Sometimes we want to see the future in HD because High Definition is so clear and beautiful. You want to see your life transitions, your relationship shifts, your advancements and setbacks and you want to see all that is going to happen until you are with the Lord. You want to see your transitions and future in HD.

Yet, that is not the way it works because God is God and we are not. I once heard that our transitions and futures in the Lord are less like HD and more like a Polaroid picture. Rather than being crystal HD clear it is slow exposure. That is often what your future transitions look like in life. God's calling for your life begins to be exposed slowly as you step out and live in full dependence on Him. I believe God has set it up this way so

that you would enjoy a relationship with Him. So that each day you would get up and seek the face of God for wisdom and direction.

As we individually and corporately transition in life, may we take a hold of God who has taken a hold of us. May we rest in God and His Sovereign Control for our good and His glory.



#### CROSSES FOR LIFE

The Village Bible Church Men's Ministry in conjunction with Sacred Heart of Jesus Catholic Church is proud to sponsor the "Crosses for Life Memorial." The memorial crosses will be on display outside the churches during the month of September.

The "Crosses for Life Memorial" is a statewide outreach project of Benton County Right to Life. The crosses have been displayed in various locations throughout the state since January 2000. The crosses represent the pre-born children that die daily in the U.S. as a result of induced abortion. The purpose of the display is to memorialize those children and increase public awareness of the magnitude of what has been called by some "The American Holocaust."

A pounding is an old-fashioned tradition celebrated in many churches where a new pastor is welcomed to the church with gifts of food. Traditionally, a pounding would provide a pastor and his family with a pounding of staples, such as a pound of flour, a pound of sugar, a pound of butter and a pound of other basic items.

VBC went a bit more modern, with items such as cereal, juice boxes, cookies, toilet paper, Kleenex, snack items and many perishable items collected.

Jason and his wife Melissa are from Skokie, Illinois. Jason grew up in Dallas. He attended Arkansas Tech University and Dallas Theological Seminary, and he received his Doctor of Ministry from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. Prior to becoming the Senior Pastor of Village Bible Church, he was the Senior Pastor of Evanston Bible Fellowship in the Chicago area from 2004-2018 and a Senior Pastor of a church in Santa Monica, California from 1997-2004. Jason and Melissa have seven children.

Dr. Jason Lancaster is only the third senior pastor in Village Bible Church history. He will officially begin his service as Village Bible Church's new pastor on September 2.




#### **Baptism**
