

- 6. Don't overload our new pastor with suggestions and requests.
- 7. Pray for Jason, Melissa and the family and let them know you are there for them.
- 8. Invite the family to your home and to community events but understand when the schedule does not allow them to accept every invitation.
- 9. Pray for yourself, asking God to help you grow closer to Him under the leadership of our new pastor.

It wouldn't hurt to continue to pray for your other pastors also as we strive to support Pastor Jason and his ministry here.



To Our Beloved VBC Family,

We can't thank you enough for all the cards and calls to our temporary MN home during Jim's surgery and initial recovery period. It was an amazing experience to see how God answered so many of your specific prayers.

You prayed that the surgeon's concern that Jim would experience excessive bleeding during surgery would not happen. This might have caused him to have to do the surgery in 2 stages. Jim's bleeding was <u>less</u> than is normally experienced with this surgery. This resulted in the surgery lasting only 5 1/2 hours rather than the expected 8 1/2 hours, so he could complete the surgery in one stage.

You prayed that God would work through the surgeon's hands. One of the doctors on the team shared with us that they had never seen the surgeon, Dr. Nassr, work in such a masterful way as he assembled the jigsaw puzzle in my lower spine that will eventually heal my problems.

Please continue to pray for both of us as we go through the recovery process.

We serve such a GREAT GOD who is in the miracle business. We believe we experienced a miracle here, so all the praise goes to our God who kept us both in His care and protection during this entire process - Ps: 91.

GriefShare Program

This program features biblical, Christ-centered teaching that focuses on grief topics associated with the death of a loved one. The DVD seminar features nationally respected grief experts and real-life stories of people, followed by a small group discussion about what was viewed. Past participants have related how helpful the information and follow-up discussion were to them.

Many grieving people find they are only beginning the work of healing when friends or family have returned to their daily life routines. Too often people, including Christians, tend to stuff their grief instead of allowing it to do the God-given work for which it is intended. Don't allow fear of what others may think to keep you from what could help you. Confidentiality is very much a part of this program.

Your bereavement experience may be recent or not so recent. You will find encouragement, comfort and help in grieving the death of a spouse, child, parent, sibling, other family member or friend. No matter what the cause of your loved ones death, this as an opportunity to be around people who understand what you are feeling. You will learn how to recognize the systems of being stuck in grief and that you do not need to live in bondage to certain emotions. You will learn valuable information about facing your new normal in life and renewing your hope for the future.

Some of the subjects covered this fall will be 'Challenges of Grief,' 'Stuck in Grief,' and 'Heaven.' Because each session is 'self-contained,' missed sessions can be made up in a subsequent seminar.

The fall GriefShare sessions will begin on Monday, September 10, and will meet each Monday morning from 9:00am—11:00am at Village Bible Church in room 110 until December 3. Chapter 11: Forgive - "Relationships can get pretty frosty if forgiveness is not part of the package. When anger and bitterness enter our minds, unforgiveness and resentment grow in our hearts."

POUNDING THE PASTOR


